## POWER OF ATTORNEY

- 4. submit and receive one-sided declarations of intent, as well as establish and cancel contractual relationships;
- 5. represent the signatory in other proceedings and all manner of out-of-court negotiations.

These powers of attorney shall apply to all instances and include all manner of ancillary proceedings (for example, arrests and interim injunctions, as well as proceedings involving cost assessment, judgment enforcement, intervention, forced sale and/or administration, deposits, insolvency, and/or settlement regarding the opposing party's assets).

They also particularly include the authorisation to file and receive services of process; transfer partial or full powers of attorney to other parties; file, withdraw, or forego appeals.

The attorney is also authorised to access records and to receive the amounts to be reimbursed from the opposing party, court cashier or other sources.
